The Symposium and Seminars are geared to diocesan and parish personnel, coordinators of youth and/or young adult ministry, adult advisers, and young adult leaders **age eighteen and over**.

<p>The Symposium is an intensive <i>Pastoral Juvenil Hispana</i> program based on the Prophets of Hope model. It offers a broad pastoral vision, content and resources for evangelizing, effective leadership training, and faith formation. Participants will take back to their local community tools to start, continue, or improve a comprehensive youth and young adult ministry, grounded on the reality of the Catholic Church and society in the USA.</p> <p>A comprehensive youth and young adult ministry requires a shared, active, and responsible leadership in the context of a small community, youth group, or apostolic movement. This approach prepares youth and young adults for their evangelizing mission and sets the foundation for a deeper pastoral training.</p> <p>Some of the themes to be covered are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analysis of the reality of Latino youth in the USA • Interpersonal relationships in the community • The Church as a community of communities • Being a Christian means knowing and following Jesus • Process of formation and growth as Church • Leadership and service in a communitarian ministry • Applying the Symposium experience in pastoral practice 		<p>This Seminar is geared to adult advisers, young adult leaders, and pastoral agents interested in <i>Pastoral Juvenil</i> in the USA. It is one of the three modules of Fe y Vida's "Certificate Program for Advisers and Leaders in <i>Pastoral Juvenil</i>," at the national level. To receive the certificate, all three modules must be completed as well as a final paper. 		<p style="text-align: center;">Spiritual Growth and Sexuality Seminar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-knowledge, spirituality, and inner healing • Christian living of sexuality <p style="text-align: center;">(Seminar B)</p>	
<p>This Seminar is geared to adult advisers, youth ministers, and trained young adult leaders. It has a twofold dimension: to reflect on personal life, and on the ministry that is being practiced. It is a seminar that helps the integration process of the participants, as well as their ability to facilitate this process in the adolescents and young adults they serve; it is neither personal nor group therapy. Themes to be covered include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Christian anthropology • Journey of self-knowledge • Spirituality and Christian spiritualities • The process of spiritual maturity, with an emphasis on inner healing and letting go of past hurts • Sexual development from the physiological, psychological, and social perspectives • Christian living of sexuality as individuals and as couples 			

The following applies to the Symposium as well as to the two Seminars:

I. LANGUAGE

Process, presentations, and materials for the Symposium and Seminars are in Spanish. Participants may express themselves in either English or Spanish. Some communities work in Spanish, others in English or bilingually, depending on language of preference.

II. REGISTRATION

Space is limited to 80 participants in the Symposium and 40 per Seminar.

The Summer Program is geared to participants 18 and over, no minors will be accepted.

A. Registration Fees

B. Room & Board

- *Group of 4, discount of \$300 (4 people X \$75 discount per person)*

III. SITE & SCHEDULE OF SYMPOSIUM AND SEMINARS

- Summer Program will be held on the campus of Seattle University (www.seattleu.edu), in Seattle, State of Washington. By air, fly into Seattle-Tacoma Airport (Sea-Tac), which is about 15 miles north of the University
- Registration: Sunday, August 9 from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Program starts at 7:00 PM
- Closing ceremony: Saturday, August 15 at 6:00 PM

IV. PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Some **partial registration scholarships** are available. To request a partial registration scholarship, please send a letter or an e-mail with your name, address, and telephone, program of interest (Symposium, Seminar A or B) to Instituto Fe y Vida, explaining your financial need, reasons for wanting to participate, as well as a summary of your pastoral background. Letters or e-mails can be written in either English or Spanish. In order to qualify, **applications must be postmarked on or before May 31, 2009.**
