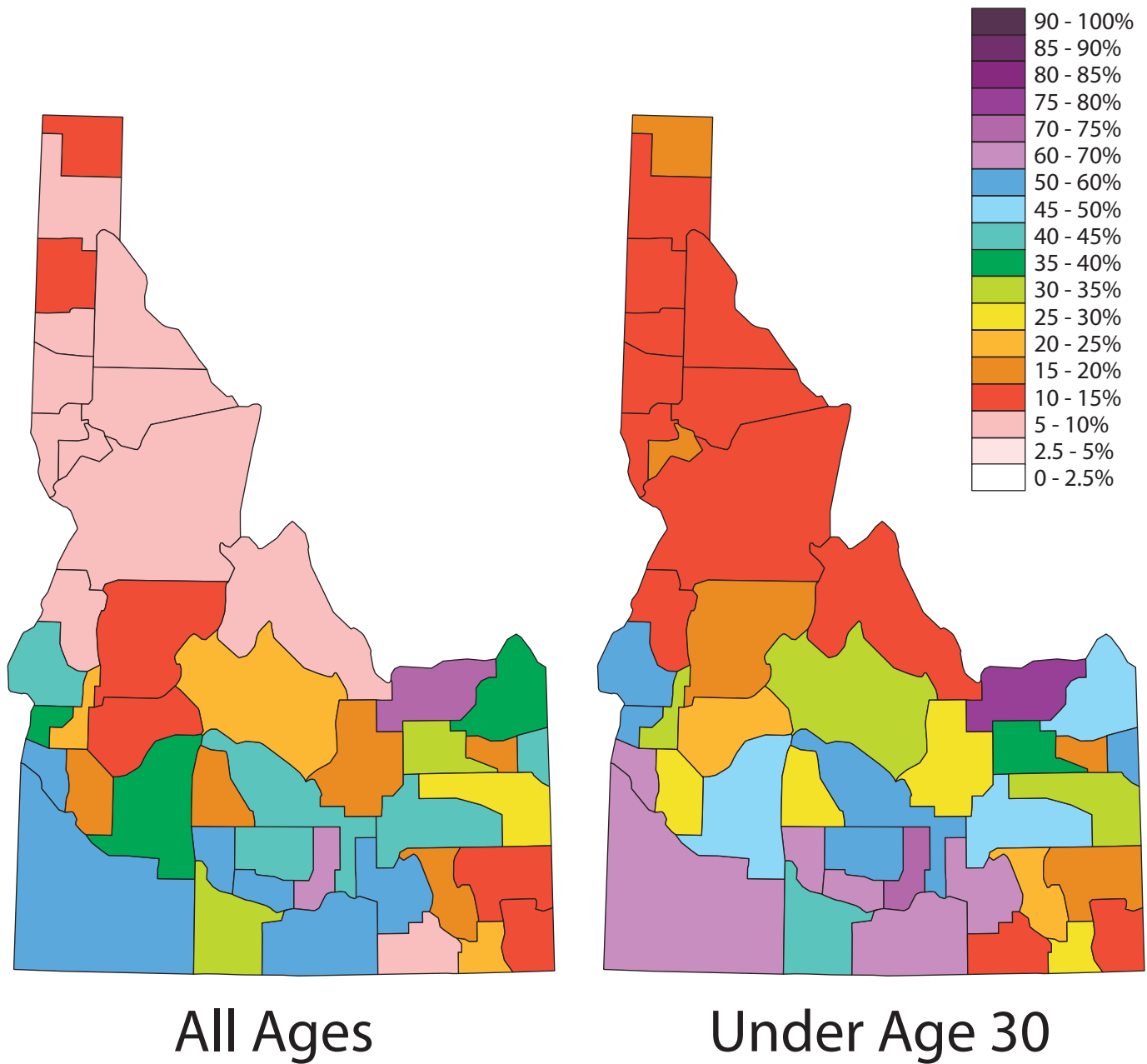




Estimated Hispanics as a Percentage of All Idaho Catholics by Age and County in 2004

* Approximations are based on U.S. Census Bureau Population Estimates by County for July 1, 2004, the 2001 American Religious Identification Survey, and the 2002 National Survey of Latinos. They are based on the assumption that 16% of White, 67% of Hispanic, 1% of Black, 15% of Asian, and 18% of Other residents are Catholic. These approximations are most reliable for counties with large populations.



Profile of Hispanic and Non-Hispanic Population in Idaho

From July 1, 2004 U.S. Census Bureau Population Estimates:

In July 2004, Hispanics made up about 9% (123,874 out of 1,393,262) of the overall Idaho population—up from 8% (101,690 out of 1,293,953) in 2000. About 96% of non-Hispanic Idahoans are “White only” as defined by the U.S. Census Bureau.

From 2001 American Religious Identification Survey and 2002 National Survey of Latinos:

About 67% of Hispanics in Idaho are Catholic

About 16% of non-Hispanics in Idaho are Catholic

Total Catholics in Idaho number about 285,000

Hispanics make up about 29% of all Catholics in Idaho

About 20% of all Idahoans are Catholic

Hispanics make up about 37.5% of all Idahoan Catholics under age 30

From March 2004 Census Current Population Survey:

National Heritage – Hispanic Idahoans

89% Mexican

2% Puerto Rican

2% Central / South American

8% “Other Spanish”

Nativity – Hispanic Idahoans

66% born in the United States

32% born in Mexico

1% born in El Salvador

1% born in Nicaragua, Puerto Rico, Peru, and “Central America”

Citizenship – Hispanic Idahoans

66% Native-born U.S. citizens

31% Not U.S. citizens

3% Foreign-born naturalized citizens

Undocumented – no sure numbers, but probably between 15% and 20% of Hispanics (between 20,000 and 26,000 individuals, only 3,000 to 4,000 of whom are under age 18)

Generation – Hispanic Idahoans Overall

34% Foreign-born

22% Children of at least one foreign-born parent

43% Children of U.S.-born parents

Generation – Minor Hispanic Idahoans (out of 55,675 Hispanics under age 18)

12% Foreign-born

34% Children of at least one foreign-born parent

54% Children of U.S.-born parents

Generation – Young Adult Hispanic Idahoans (out of 34,234 Hispanics ages 18 to 29)

46% Foreign-born

19% Children of at least one foreign-born parent

35% Children of U.S.-born parents



Generation – Adult Hispanic Idahoans (out of 46,088 Hispanics over age 30)
 55% Foreign-born
 9% Children of at least one foreign-born parent
 36% Children of U.S.-born parents
